Parameters for bores RRLGDTSFMB001D & RRLGDTSFMB001S were not sampled in quarter 3 2018.

Parameters for bores RRLGDPB026 & RRLGDPB027 were not sampled in quarter 4 2018. Parameters for bores RRLGDPB025/57 were not monitored in quarter 3 and quarter 4 2018.

What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance?

Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance:

Due to boggy conditions surrounding bores RRLGDTSFMB001D & RRLGDTSFMB001S, access was restricted which prevented the sampling equipment accessing the bores, consequently samples were not obtained during this quarter. Access to this area was improved allowing for sampling to occur in quarter 4 2018.

During quarter 4 the pumps installed in RRLGDPB026 & RRLGDPB027 were experiencing mechanical issues during this period and were removed for repairs.

During quarter 3 & 4 bore RRLGDPB025/57 generator was removed for repairs and was not reinstated during these reporting periods. The bore and pipe work remained within the bore hole
