Mine void development encroached on PB22 which resulted in the bore being decommissioned. The alternative bore PB23 was unable to be accessed in March 2025 due to its location being designated an area of geotechnical instability preventing safe access.				
Additionally, MB21 is believed to have potentially been impacted by geotechnical instability resulting in what is understood to be a blockage preventing sampling.
