Date(s) of non-Condition no: 1 of L9254/2020/1 13/04/2021 compliance: Details of non-compliance: All weaner and finisher sheds listed in Schedule 2, Table 7 were not cleaned weekly. Condition 1 requires the licence holder to maintain and operate site infrastructure and equipment listed in Schedule 2 Table 7 and located at the corresponding infrastructure location in accordance with the corresponding operational requirement set out in Schedule 2 Table 7. Table 7 states that the 7 conventional sheds and 2 additional sheds (constructed under works approval W5865/2015/1) are to be cleaned weekly. The weaner and finisher sheds are cleaned weekly on a rotational basis. This means that each weaner shed is cleaned every 6 weeks and each finisher shed is cleaned every 11 – 12 weeks. Each shed takes 3 days to clean and 1 day to dry before the pigs can be rehoused in the shed. It is not practicable to clean all sheds each week as there is not enough vacant space on the premises to house all pigs temporarily whilst each shed is cleaned weekly. In addition, cleaning each shed weekly would increase water usage by a factor of 8. The waste water infrastructure has not been designed to accommodate this volume of waste water. What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance? NOTE - please attach maps or diagrams to provide insight into the precise location of where the noncompliance took place. None. Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance: Westpork interpreted Condition 1, Schedule 2, Table 7 as meaning that cleaning of the weaner and finisher sheds would occur weekly on a rotational basis, not that every weaner and every finisher shed would be cleaned weekly. Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:

Westpork has engaged Aurora Environmental to prepare a licence amendment application to amend Condition 1, Schedule 2, Table 7 to clearly state that:

1 x weaner and 1 x finisher shed will be cleaned on a weekly basis with each weaner shed cleaned every 6 weeks and each finisher shed cleaned every 11-12 weeks.
