Application for exemption under regulation 5(1)(b)
of the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Levy Regulations 2008*

Regulation 5 of the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Levy Regulations 2008* (Levy Regulations) sets out the circumstances under which licensees can apply to claim an exemption from the regulations.

Licensees are required to use this form to apply for an exemption under **regulation 5(1)(b)** being:

waste that is not disposed of to landfill but is collected and stored at a licensed landfill for reuse, reprocessing, recycling or use in energy recovery;

This exemption provision is intended for only Category 64 or 65 putrescible landfill facilities.

Applicants should note that exemptions should be in place prior to 28 days after the end of the return period to avoid landfill levy liability arising.

Before submitting this application form please ensure you have done the following:

- Completed and signed the form as required.
- Included copies of the supporting information required as set out in the form.
- Read the Landfill Levy Fact Sheet No. 2 – Exemptions from the Levy Regulations (www.der.wa.gov.au/landfilllevy)
