Application for exemption under regulation 5(1)(f)
of the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Levy Regulations 2008*

Regulation 5 of the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Levy Regulations 2008* (Levy Regulations) sets out the circumstances under which licensees can apply to claim an exemption from the regulations.

Licensees are required to use this form to apply for an exemption under **regulation 5(1)(f)** being:

waste that —

- (i) is deposited on a shoreline by the action of water; and
- (ii) is reasonably removed from the shoreline by a public authority to mitigate or prevent a risk of harm to human health or the environment; and
- (iii) cannot reasonably be reused, reprocessed, recycled or used in energy recovery;

Applicants should note that exemptions should be in place prior to 28 days after the end of the return period to avoid landfill levy liability arising.

Before submitting this application form please ensure you have done the following:

- Completed and signed the form as required.
- Included copies of the supporting information required as set out in the form.
- Read the Landfill Levy Fact Sheet No. 2 – Exemptions from the Levy Regulations (www.der.wa.gov.au/landfilllevy).
