Interpretation

- (d) any reference to an Australian or other standard, guideline, or code of practice means the version of the standard, guideline, or code of practice in force at the time of granting of this licence and includes any amendments to the standard, guideline or code of practice which may occur from time to time during the course of the licence;
- (e) unless specified otherwise, any reference to a section of an Act refers to that section of the EP Act; and
- (f) unless specified otherwise, all definitions are in accordance with the EP Act.

NOTE: This licence requires specific conditions to be met but does not provide any implied authorisation for other emissions, discharges, or activities not specified in this licence.

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Licence conditions

The Licence Holder must ensure that the following conditions are complied with:

Waste Acceptance

1. The Licence Holder must only bury on the Premises, wastes of a waste type, which does not exceed the corresponding rate at which waste is received, and which meets the corresponding acceptance specifications set out in Table 1.

Table 1: Types of waste authorised for burial on the Premises

Waste type	Rate at which waste is received	Acceptance specification
Clean fill	Combined total of more than 50,000,	Waste containing visible
Inert waste type 1	but not more than 500,000 tonnes per year	asbestos or ACM shall not be accepted for burial

2. The Licence Holder must ensure that wastes buried on the Premises are only subjected to the process set out in Table 2 and in accordance with any process requirements described in that table.

Records and reporting

- **3.** The Licence Holder must:
 - (a) undertake an audit of their compliance with the conditions of this licence during the preceding Annual Period; and
 - (b) prepare and submit to the CEO by no later than 31 days after the end of that annual period an Annual Audit Compliance Report in the approved form.

The boundary of the Prescribed Premises is shown in black on the map below.




Figure 1: Map of the boundary of the prescribed premises

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
