Interpretation

- (c) where tables are used in a condition, each row in a table constitutes a separate condition:
- (d) any reference to an Australian or other standard, guideline or code of practice in this works approval means the version of the standard, guideline or code of practice in force at the time of granting of this works approval and includes any amendments to the standard, guideline or code of practice which may occur from time to time during the course of the works approval;
- (e) unless specified otherwise, any reference to a section of an Act refers to that section of the EP Act; and
- (f) unless specified otherwise, all definitions are in accordance with the EP Act.

NOTE: This works approval requires specific conditions to be met but does not provide any implied authorisation for other emissions, discharges, or activities not specified in this works approval.

Works approval conditions

The works approval holder must ensure that the following conditions are complied with:

Time limited operations phase

Commencement and duration

- 1. The works approval holder may conduct time limited operations for the export of MSC:
 - (a) for a maximum of five shipments of MSC from the original issue date of this works approval; and
 - (b) until such time as a licence for that item of infrastructure is granted in accordance with Part V of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*.

Time limited operations requirements

2. During time limited operations, the works approval holder must ensure that the premises infrastructure and equipment listed in Table 1 and located at the corresponding infrastructure location is maintained and operated in accordance with the corresponding operational requirement set out in Table 1:

Notification during time limited operations

- 3. The works approval holder must notify the CEO, at least 7 days prior to, the commencement date of each shipment of MSC exported from the premises.
- **4.** The works approval holder must notify the CEO, within 7 days after, the completion date of each shipment of MSC exported from the premises.

Compliance reporting

- 5. The works approval holder must submit to the CEO a summary report on the time limited operations within 28 calendar days of the completion date of the fourth shipment authorised under time limited operations.
- **6.** The works approval holder must ensure the summary report required by condition 5 includes:
 - (a) a summary of environmental radiation and fugitive dust monitoring conducted during each shipment of MSC, including a correlation of the results against dust exceedances recorded at the premises;
 - (b) where environmental performance has not met expectations, measures proposed to meet the requirements of conditions of this works approval, together with timescales for implementing the proposed measures.

Records and reporting (general)

- 7. The works approval holder must obtain and maintain accurate records of the representative moisture content for each shipment of MSC during the time limited operational phase.
- **8.** The works approval holder must record the following information in relation to complaints received by the works approval holder (whether received directly from a complainant or

forwarded to them by the Department or another party) about any alleged emissions from the Premises:

- (a) the name and contact details of the complainant, (if provided);
- (b) the time and date of the complaint;
- (c) the complete details of the complaint and any other concerns or other issues raised; and
- (d) the complete details and dates of any action taken by the works approval holder to investigate or respond to any complaint.
- **9.** The works approval holder must maintain accurate and auditable books including the following records, information, reports, and data required by this works approval:
 - (c) the time limited operations conducted in accordance with conditions 1 and 2 inclusive; and
 - (d) complaints received under condition 8.
- **10.** The books specified under condition 9 must:
 - (a) be legible;
 - (b) if amended, be amended in such a way that the original version(s) and any subsequent amendments remain legible and are capable of retrieval;
 - (c) be retained by the works approval holder for the duration of the works approval; and
 - (d) be available to be produced to an inspector or the CEO as required.
